Stand B18 in Hall 11 at this years NEC International Motorcycle Show will display the entire 1996 Triumph 12 model strong line-up. Also on display will be the full line-up of clothes and accessories available through Triumph's UK dealer network.

Making its UK public debut will be the new generation Trophy 900 and 1200 models. Both reflect a significant number of improvements and refinements positioning the Trophy further into the luxury tourer category.

Also on display will be both the gold and violet colour variants of the all new Adventurer. A stylish, easy to ride American influenced luxury version of Triumph's best selling Thunderbird model. One of the two machines has been fully accessorised reflecting the degree of personalisation possible on this roadster.

In contrast to the new line-up there will be a three year old Trident 900 which has clocked up a staggering 240,000 relatively trouble free miles under the ownership of Andrew Utting, an international courier. The bike is testimony of the durability of the Hinckley manufactured range of motorcycles endorsing the triple motor's bullet-proof image.
