**TRIUMPH - SPEED TRIPLE CHALLENGE & TRANSATLANTIC CHALLENGE FOR 1996**

The second season of the highly successful £75,000 MOBIL 1 Triumph Speed Triple Challenge, linked to an exciting revamped TransAtlantic Challenge, are the highlights of Triumph's motorcycle racing programme in 1996.

The eight round Mobil 1 sponsored Triumph Speed Triple Challenge series will again attract some of this country's finest riders, chasing the £2000 1st prize from a £8270 prize fund per round.

In addition, Team Triumph Great Britain v Team Triumph USA, all on 900cc Triumph Speed Triples, will herald the revival of one of Britain's most popular match race events, the TransAtlantic Challenge, to be held at Donington Park on Bank Holiday Monday, 27 May 1996.

The TransAtlantic will comprise a maximum of 12 riders per country, riding machines prepared to identical specification by Triumph at their Hinckley headquarters, and run over three 'sprint' races.

A round at the British Grand Prix at Donington Park on 20/21 July is the pinnacle of a superb calendar for the Mobil 1 Triumph Speed Triple Challenge, which will be run to the same successful format as 1995.
